

- 1) The 41st annual Moopy Memorial opens our 2026 season at QCC. This is a singles event that has withstood the test of time.
- 2) Cronies is the first foursome scramble of the year. The 12-year-old event is played at Cronin's.
- 3) The first doubles event is the 27-year-old RAW DP Challenge. Scramble the first 6 holes, play alternate shots for next 6 and best ball for the final 6 holes of the day.
- 4) The Red, White & Blue is a 14-year-old event with some changes this year. Glenn and Erwin have taken over as the sponsors. The format is now a doubles shamble. And scoring no longer dictates the tee boxes used on the following hole. Just rotate from red to white to blue through the round.
- 5) The initial Woodworth Open adds another singles event to the calendar. Low gross and low net champions will be crowned.
- 6) Father's Day is celebrated for the 6th time with a foursome scramble hosted by a father and his son.
- 7) The third regular season singles event is the 38th annual 2-Day-Woody. One round of golf on consecutive days. If you can't play both days, you can play just one round and receive credit for TOC eligibility.
- 8) A 11 year old doubles scramble is next with The Give a DAM Memorial.
- 9) Back-to-back doubles scrambles in August. This is The Val-edictorian bringing us back to QCC.
- 10) The middle of August is marked by the 8th annual Ma Powers memorial. This year it is being converted to a doubles scramble.
- 11) We'll head back to Cronin's for the 15th annual MGM Grand. It's another family sponsored scramble, but this is a foursome event.
- 12) Another 11-year-old event on the calendar is the S.O.B. The unique format is that of a foursome best ball scoring system.
- 13) The Tournament of Champions is a post season, invitational event. Individuals will have to win the cash prizes all by themselves. To be invited to this singles event, a player must do one of the following: (criteria subject to alteration)

a) Play in at least 6 regular season events

b) Win one regular season event and play in at least 4

**c) Be a past T.O.C. winner and play in at least 4
regular season events**
